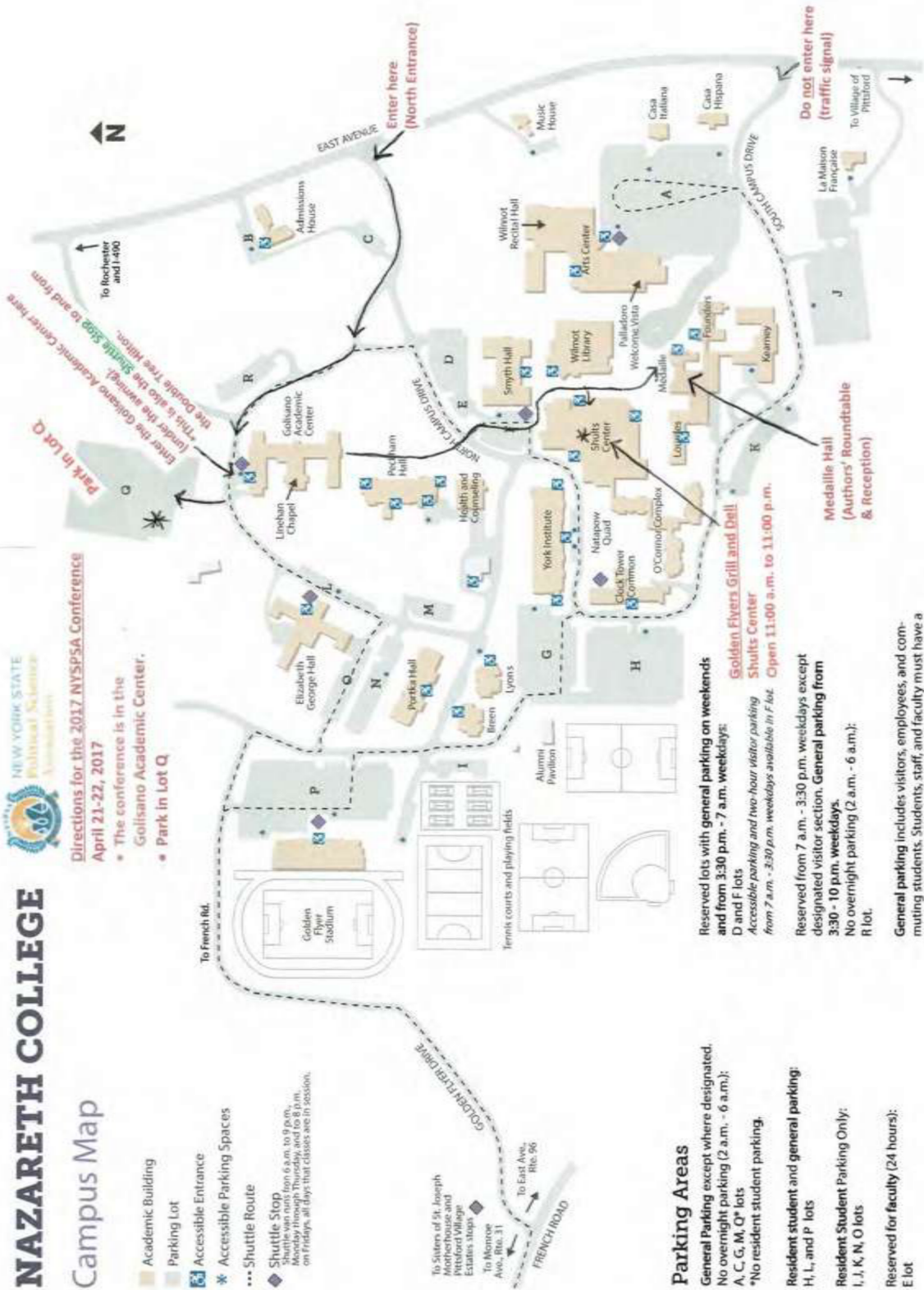
## Campus Map

- Reserved for faculty (24 hours):** E lot
